Non-Resident Entrance Pass

Out-of-state residents can purchase a Non-Resident Entrance Pass which allows **free entrance** on an unlimited number of visits and **discounted camping fees** for a year. A pass costs \$35 / vehicle. The State Park Entrance Pass is valid for one year from month of issue.
